- ✍ Great for students who struggle with performance anxiety in formal situations

**FOR:** Piano or Voice

**DATE:** Saturday, December 5, 2009  
Sunday, December 6, 2009

**PLACE:** North Point Mall – 2 locations within the mall (we must fill up two pianos before scheduling a third)

**FEE:** \$9.00 per student

**REGISTRATION:** All registration will be handled via e-mail to Rhonda Freeman at [rhofree@aol.com](mailto:rhofree@aol.com). You will submit both your first and second choice of location, date, and time using the **Sign-Up Form**. Your time slot will be confirmed to you via e-mail. A deposit of \$40 is required to reserve a block of time and can be mailed to Rhonda or handed to her at a meeting. Registration **deadline is November 10th** (the November meeting). After November 10 teachers without full paperwork and fees will forfeit their time slots. Rhonda Freeman will need the following by that date:

1. **Check (total number of students x \$9)**
2. **Sign-Up Form**
3. **Performer List**

**PERFORMANCE TIME ALLOWED:** Each studio may request up to 2 hours, in 30-minute increments. Remember that we have many students wanting to perform. Please plan your time carefully. We will try to honor all requests over 1 hour and will try not to split such a request between the two mall locations, but this cannot be guaranteed. Reservations will be scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis as soon as they are received via e-mail.

**MUSIC:** Most students play “holiday” music, but that is not a requirement. In previous years, students have enjoyed playing solos, duets, and quartets. Duets, quartets, or small ensembles provide a good way to include more students in a short period of time and give them a chance to play more. Students and/or teachers must fill out the repertoire list at the mall prior to performing. MTNA pays all royalties and this repertoire list must be completed.
